Discussion and Application Questions From The Message: (30 -35 Minutes)

1. In the lesson today, it was taught that worship occurred daily in the Scriptures. What constitutes worship for you each day?
2. Read Acts 2:42-47. What, in your opinion, qualifies as “worship” from this text? Why?
3. Is prayer “worship?” Why?
4. How often should we pray? When we pray during the week, does this qualify as worship? Why or Why not?
5. One idea taught this morning was that worship occurred, in the Scriptures, spontaneously as a result of an awareness of God. (Example was Moses being in God’s presence when writing the second set of stone tablets.) When are you aware of God during the week and what could be an expression of worship during that moment of awareness?
6. Other times of spontaneous worship, in the Scriptures, occurred as a response to the presence and power of Jesus. Does that occur for you today? If so, how? If not, why?
7. Read Romans 12:1-2.
8. The later versions say this is our true and proper worship. From these verses, what do you think qualifies as worship?
