Getting to Know You (5-10 minutes):

Discussion and Application Questions from the Message (30-35 minutes):

- 1. Read Luke 15:1-24. What is the context of Jesus telling these parables? What stands out to you about JOY from this passage? Had you noticed before how prevalent a theme that joy is in these parables?
- 2. How does joy differ from happiness? How do they overlap?

Today's sermon shared 5 Daily Choices to Grow Joy:

- 1. Look with hope.
- 2. Share grace/mercy freely.
- 3. Welcome radically with affection.
- 4. Give sacrificially.
- 5. Celebrate others always.
- 3. These were based on clues from the words about and said by the Father in the last parable. Discuss how you see the Father illustrating each of these 5 in the story. (ex: I see the Father welcoming radically with affection by...)
- 4. Discuss real life examples of how someone could make choices to put each of these 5 choices into practice in their daily life and why you think they would lead to growing in joy. (ex: I can choose to celebrate others by....)
- 5. What is one of the 5 choices that I can work on making every day this week that will help me grow joy in my life? Share it with the group and why you picked that one.
