Discussion and Application Questions From The Message: (30 -35 Minutes)

1. As a child, what were you taught about Satan?
2. Do you think there are any misconceptions or misunderstandings about Satan and how he operates? If so, what are they?
3. From your knowledge, or from the message, how does the Bible describe Satan?
4. In your opinion, how does Satan work today?
5. Satan was a created angel that was given free will. Why do you suppose God created angels with free will, thus giving them the choice to rebel?
6. Satan's sin was pride and wanting to set himself up above God. (See Isaiah 14:12-14 and Ezekiel 28:13-17). As magnificent and filled with splendor as he was, why was that not good enough for him? Why have this type of sinful pride?
7. Do we struggle with this same sin? If so, how?
8. Last week in the message we discussed the passage that taught our enemy prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Do you have trouble viewing Satan that way? Why or why not?
9. From last week's message, we taught that Satan only wins if we let him. What does that mean to you?
10. If Satan isn't omnipresent (everywhere all the time) like God is, does this mean there are times in our lives he doesn't tempt or distract us? Why or why not?
11. Jeff taught that Satan leads an army that is opposed to God, all that is good, and sets us squarely in his/their sights. Who could be included in this army? Explain.
12. Read Romans 8:31-39. How does this passage encourage you in your personal battle with Satan?
