Hearing Impaired Assisted Device

The WaveCAST Receiver app allows listeners to hear the audio on their personal, Wi-Fi connected devices, such as a mobile phone or Bluetooth enabled hearing aids.

The WaveCAST App can be downloaded from the Google Play Store for Android devices or the Apple App Store for iOS devices. Download the WaveCAST. It is recommended that the app is downloaded in advance. Join the WaveCAST Wi-Fi Network. Once the WaveCAST App is downloaded, join the same Wi-Fi network that the audio is being broadcast over (Kingwood Guest).





Options for Listening:

- Connect a pair of headphones to the headphone jack on your device.
- Connect a Bluetooth headset or Bluetooth-enabled hearing aids.

If NO SERVERS FOUND is displayed, then make sure you are on the "Kingwood Guest" Wi-Fi network. It should show "Kingwood Hearing System" then just touch that and you are connected to the system.

Set your volume for your hearing aids or hearing device and enjoy the singing and sermon as you have not heard in a while.
