3. Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

  2. Read verse 18 again; how can this verse give us a great sense of purpose and meaning as a part of the body of Christ?
  3. Verse 22 reminds us "that we can't do without" the body parts that seem weaker or less significant. What are some of those ministries, or who are some of those people that might be at Kingwood? What can we do as a church family to ensure all parts of the body know they are valued and important to our church family?
4. Last week, Jeff talked about how God, as the gardener, either cuts or prunes various parts of the vine based on whether they produce fruit. How can we, as a church family, ensure that our church family stays connected to the vine and doesn't get cut off?
5. Spend a few minutes in prayer for those who might feel like they aren't connected to others on the vine. Also, pray for those parts of the body who might feel insignificant that they may have the assurance that they are valued and appreciated.
