- 1. Read any of the following; Matthew 21:1-11, Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:29-44; John 12:12-19. All of these give us the triumphal entry into Jerusalem.
- 2. If you were writing this story, is this the way you would have had Jesus enter Jerusalem on the Sunday before His crucifixion? Why or Why not? If no, how would you have written the story?
- 3. Read Matthew 21:12-17.
- 4. What stands out to you about this story of Jesus clearing the temple?
- 5. We know Jesus never sinned. Was He angry at this moment? What can we learn from this story that might relate to our own lives?
- 6. Read Matthew 26:1-5 and 14-16.
- 7. After seeing all that he saw during his time with Jesus, why would Judas agree to betray Jesus? What motivated him?
- 8. What lessons from the life of Judas can we learn for our own lives?
- 9. Read Luke 22:39-46.
- 10. Can you relate to the amount of anguish Jesus was feeling in the Garden of Gethsemane? Why or why not?
- 11. What did Jesus do when he was in anguish and what can be learned from Gethsemane that can help us in our own lives?
- 12. Jesus went through these few days because He had you in mind. What are your thoughts when you think about that?
