FROM THE PREACHER'S DESK

January 29, 2023

It is great to be back with you today as I have been in Honduras the last two Sundays. The team and I arrived back at the building just after 10:00 p.m. last Sunday evening. We were tired but blessed as our work went well. A couple of you have asked who we worked with, and what we did, so let me take a moment to answer that. We worked with Breaking Chains out of Tegucigalpa. BC is a ministry that was started in 2009 by a single woman named Amber Foster. Amber moved to Honduras and began passing out food on the streets of the capital city and later formed Breaking Chains as a way to reach out to those suffering urban poverty in the city. The name comes from the idea that we all have hope, in Christ, to be freed from the shackles that bind us. I have had the privilege of serving as the president of the Board of Directors for about 10 years. You can learn more about the work by visiting www.bchonduras.org.

Our work centered on the community of Montes where Breaking Chains has built houses, held vacation bible schools, medical clinics, and more. This community, filled with poverty, gave a piece of land with a one room building on it to be used jointly by BC and the community. Our group began the process of building a bathroom, installed fencing around the property, ran some new electrical, as well as cleaned up the property. We also provided sandwiches on the streets of Tegucigalpa one evening, visited with the young adults at the BC building, and visited the Integrity School where BC sponsors children to attend this bi-lingual school. A couple of us also had the opportunity to visit and pray with some of the families in Montes. It was a fantastic week and I appreciate the prayers of all of you as we were away. I enjoyed working with this group from Kingwood and I look forward to further opportunities to serve.
